## Scheduling Tips

- ✓ **Stick to a consistent schedule.** Daily use, even in short sessions, leads to stronger reading progress.
- ✓ **Use Amira flexibly,** individually, small groups or as a whole class.
- ✓ **Differentiate time based on student needs** (e.g., extra time for struggling students).
- ✓ **Tap into low-structure times,** such as arrival or morning work, for Amira use.
- ✓ **Consider assigning Amira as homework** for students with device access at home.
